If you finish early, practice today's memory verse with children and let them complete today's coloring sheet.

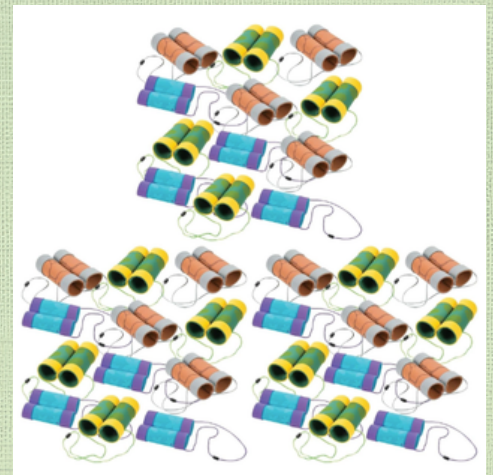

RAINFOREST BINOCULARS

1. Hand each child materials needed to create their rainforest binoculars.
2. Model for children each step of how to put their binoculars together using the provided directions.
3. If needed utilize extra hot glue to secure foam pieces (adults only).
4. Help children with threading their string through each side of the binoculars.
5. Write each child's name on their binoculars with sharpie.

RAIN STICKS

1. Give each child a paper towel tube and markers. Have them decorate the outside of their tubes with the markers drawing colorful designs and patterns.
2. Using a sheet of foil roll and wrap foil into one long strip, then wrap the foil around dowel rod to create a coiled foil strip.
3. Have children put one felt piece on end of their tube and wrap it with a rubber band securing the end closed.
4. Carefully place the coiled foil strip into the tube and using the funnel pour $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cup of rice into the tube.
5. With another piece of felt and rubber band, help the children secure the other end closed.

If you finish early, practice today's memory verse with children and let them complete today's coloring sheet.



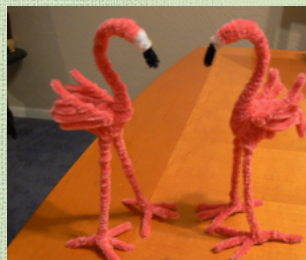

PIPE CLEANER ANIMALS

1. Let the children come in and sit down and select the colored pipe cleaners for their animal creations. They will be making a chameleon and flamingo but they do not have to be pink and green and can be whatever color the child wants them to be.
2. Using the video tutorial on Playlister on the TV, play the 2 tutorial videos to show children how to create their animals.
3. Once they have completed their animal creation if they would like to make a second animal they can.
4. Once the child's finished, have them bring their animal to the googly eye station and one of the volunteers hot glue the eyes onto their animals.
5. Using a masking tape tag and sharpie, tag the animals and write the child's name on the masking tape to keep track of what animals belong to who.

ELEMENTARY SUNCATCHERS

1. Have children choose which animal they'd like to paint for their suncatcher. One per child. Write the child's name in small print on the back of their animal with sharpie.

2. Model how to paint using the paint tubes to fill in each section of their animal completely. Allow children time to paint their animals. Once their animal is painted set it aside to dry.

3. Show children how to bead the string their animal can hang from in their window. Have them bead their string and then assist them with tying it to their animal at the top provided loop hole. Add suction cup to top of string for hanging.
