## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

## 2 Kings 4:1-7

"The miracle of Elisha for a widow and her sons demonstrated God's compassion for His image bearers."

- 1. How would you define compassion? When you think about who God is, does the term "compassionate" immediately come to mind? Why or why not?
- 2. In verse 1, why was this woman's situation so dire that she would cry out to Elisha? When have you been in a situation so desperate that you cried out for help?
- 3. Look at verses 2-7, how did the Lord demonstrate the abundance of His compassion through this miracle for the widow and her sons?
- 4. What should we make of God's method of provision in this miracle taking a little and providing more than enough?
- 5. What are some circumstances in your life that you need to cry out to God about? Cry out to God's people about? In what areas of your life do you need to demonstrate faith that God is powerful, compassionate and faithful to supply all your needs?
- 6. How will you show God's compassion to others in the coming days and point them to Jesus?
