DISCUSSION GUIDE:

- 2. What does this story in 2 Samuel 9 tell us about the character of God?
- 3. In Matthew 11:28-30, Jesus tells us what his heart is like. What does he say? What does this mean for us as followers of Jesus?
- 4. What about your life right now feels burdensome? How do we "hand over" these burdens to God?
