

DAY 3: WAITING WITH PURPOSE

READING: PSALM 27:13-14; ISAIAH 40:28-31

DEVOTIONAL: WAITING ON GOD IS NOT PASSIVE RESIGNATION BUT ACTIVE TRUST. WHILE YOU WAIT, GOD IS WORKING IN THE SUPERNATURAL REALM, ARRANGING CIRCUMSTANCES, PREPARING HEARTS, AND POSITIONING YOU FOR BREAKTHROUGH. THE PSALMIST ENCOURAGES US TO WAIT ON THE LORD AND BE OF GOOD COURAGE, FOR HE WILL STRENGTHEN OUR HEARTS. WAITING IS NEVER WASTED TIME WHEN SPENT WITH GOD. DURING SEASONS OF WAITING, ENGAGE MORE DEEPLY WITH HIS WORD, INTENSIFY YOUR PRAYER LIFE, AND WORSHIP WITH EXPECTATION. GOD OFTEN USES WAITING PERIODS TO DEVELOP SPIRITUAL MATURITY AND PREPARE US FOR THE VERY THING WE ARE REQUESTING. TODAY, EXAMINE YOUR WAITING: ARE YOU WAITING ON GOD WITH IMPATIENCE, OR WAITING FOR GOD WITH CONFIDENT EXPECTATION? CHOOSE TO WORSHIP WHILE YOU WAIT.
