1. What does the text mean when it calls the woman from Tekoa "wise"? How were her words right, and how were they wrong?
2. What are some examples of "foolish wisdom" in our own culture?
3. Why do people sometimes let a sense of shame for past sins keep them from standing firmly on God's word with their own children? Why is this a wrong (and harmful) way to think?
4. The woman of Tekoa emphasizes God's mercy to the exclusion of His justice. Why is it important that we acknowledge both the mercy of God as well as the justice of God? How do both of those attributes come together at the cross of Christ?
