1. Jesus is truly God and truly man. How does this passage either challenge or prove the ways we conceive of Jesus' divine and human natures?

2. Jesus twice tells his disciples to pray that they may not enter into temptation. How does prayer prepare us for trials and temptations?

3. The passage describes Jesus as being in distress and agony. What is the source of this agony?

4. Jesus prays, "Not my will, but yours be done." Is this a prayer of faith?

5. Jesus asked the Father to remove the cup from him. Did God answer his prayer? Why didn't he remove the cup?
