1. Why should we describe faith as "not just believing the information the Bible contains, but believing God's promise?"

2. Why does God emphasize that his promise to David is part of his unfolding plan and promises that he has been making throughout the Old Testament?

3. How does God's promise of steadfast love, even after the iniquity of David's sons, offer encouragement to believers?

4. How does Jesus provide a more complete fulfillment to God's promise David than Solomon, or any of David's other descendants?
