1. Why do you think Luke begins his section on the Passion Week by highlighting who Jesus is, especially noting his role as prophet, priest, and king?
2. How does the story of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem demonstrate that Jesus is the king, and yet unlike any other king in history?
3. What is the role of a prophet? How does Jesus fulfill the office of a prophet for his people?
4. Why does Jesus drive people out of the temple? What does this teach us about Jesus' role as priest?
5. What are the different responses to Jesus in this passage? How does this passage challenge us to respond rightly to Christ?
