1. Compare how the Jewish elders speak of the centurion (verses 4 and 5) with how the centurion speaks of <i>himself</i> (verse 6). How does this teach us about the proper way to view ourselves in relation to God?
2. Why is it an encouragement to know that Jesus has all authority over sickness and disease (even when He may not choose to heal)?
3. How does Jesus rebuke the religious pride of the Jews in verse 9?
4. Why are we so prone to compare ourselves to other people? What is the proper standard to which we should compare ourselves?
