2 Samuel 17:15–29 | “Faithful Provision”

1. How did Absalom demonstrate a desire to abandon the reliable wisdom of a previous generation in favor of a new and “fresh” point of view? How do we see that same tendency in our own day?
2. In what ways does this passage show us that God uses all kinds of people and all kinds of circumstances to carry out his plans and purposes for his kingdom? How does this encourage and motivate us?
3. How should we examine our own hearts in light of the tragic examples of Ahithophel (2 Sam. 17:23) and Judas (Matt 26:20–25; 27:3–5)?
4. In what ways does God show His sovereignty, faithfulness, and provision in this passage? How has He done the same in your own life?
