Luke 8:40–56 | “Two Daughters”

1. How does this passage emphasize that no one is immune from suffering?
2. Why is the story of Jairus’ daughter “interrupted” by the story of the woman with a discharge of blood? What do we learn by the relationship between these two healing stories?
3. After the woman with a bleeding condition is healed, why does Jesus make a special effort to draw her out into the open?
4. What encouragement can we draw from knowing that death is only sleep for those who are in Christ?
5. How does this passage teach us to cast *all* our cares on the Lord, whether big or small?
