1. Given all the different sins recorded in the Bible, what makes Judas' betrayal of Jesus particularly shocking?

2. The text says that "Satan entered Judas," yet Judas was still responsible for his actions. How do Satan's influence and human responsibility fit together?

3. What is the relationship between betrayal and the concept of falling away from Christ?

4. What do you believe caused or motivated Judas to betray Jesus?

5. The passage contrasts Judas's preparations to betray Christ with Jesus's preparations for the coming Passover meal. What does the juxtaposition of these stories teach us about the sovereignty of God?
