- 1. Do people still worship idols in our day and time?
- 2. Why do you think God cuts off Dagon's head and arms?
- 3. Why is it significant that the ark of the covenant comes back to Israel without the Jewish people having to go back and retrieve it?
- 4. How can we strike a balance between two facts: that God is totally self-sufficient and that he graciously uses us in his service?*
- 5. Why does God judge the people in Beth-Shemesh? Does their decision to send the ark away as well reveal something about their attitude towards God?
