1.	Does God choose every king/president, including the bad ones?
2.	Can a Christian's sin put him outside of the will of God in a way that jeopardizes the promise that all things work together for good? (Romans 8:28)
3.	Do you see any parallels between Saul's appointment to be king and Paul's observation in 1 Cor. 1:26–31: "Not many of you were wise according to worldly standards?"
4.	The Spirit of God rushed on Saul in a way that made him a new man. In what ways has your relationship with God caused the old to pass away and the new to come? (2 Cor. 5:17)
5.	After Saul's victory against Nahash, Samuel invites everyone to "renew the kingdom." How might this paint a picture that helps us explain Jesus and our response to him?
