- 1. What does it mean that God is light? Why would John use this truth to introduce his conversation about sin?
- 2. What does it mean to walk in darkness? Why is this incompatible with true Christianity?
- 3. Why could we expect Christian fellowship to be both a result and a means by which we walk in the light?
- 4. Should Christians expect our battle with sin to get easier in this life? Will there ever be a time when we have no sins left to confess?
- 5. Why would John say that God is just to forgive us? Why is forgiveness a justice issue, and not merely a mercy issue, for God?
- 6. What are common ways that people are inclined to deny that they have sinned? Why would these lead us toward self-deception?
- 7. What does it mean that Jesus is the propitiation for our sins? Why is this relevant to his work as our advocate?
