1. Why can Saul be seated "on the height," and yet still be so paranoid and afraid?

2. Saul becomes a type of the antichrist as he strikes against the priests of God. How do modern day antichrists strike against God and his kingdom?

3. How can a Christian explain/understand that Ahimelech died even though he had done the right thing in supporting David?

4. How can comparing Saul's words, "you shall surely die," with David's words, "with me you will be in safekeeping," act as a pattern that illustrates the message of the gospel?
