5. We reassure our hearts before God by keeping his commandments. Is this strategy a fix for when we find our hearts condemning us or preventative maintenance to keep our hearts from condemning us (or perhaps both)?
6. How does a confident heart before God affect the way we pray?
7. Should we expect to get everything they ask for when we pray to God?
8. How do we sense the Holy Spirit's presence to confirm that God abides in us?
