- 1. Why is it crucial for a Christian to emphasize that our horn is exalted "in the Lord?" Why would leaving those last three words off be a problem?
- 2. Why does Hannah focus on God's characteristics in verse 2? Is there a connection between our joy (vs. 1) and God's holiness (vs. 2)?
- 3. Why does the sovereignty of God offer hope for those who are humble?
- 4. There is a modern hymn titled "The Christian's Hope Can Never Fail." The opening two lines say, "We travel through a barren land, With dangers thick on every hand?" Why, in spite of this, do we believe that the Christian's hope can never fail?
