

## **Small Group Questions: Luke 22:14-30**

**August 23, 2026**

1. Jesus knew he would be betrayed the same night he celebrated the Passover meal with his disciples, yet he earnestly wanted to eat the Passover with them. Why do you think that was?
2. Jesus said he would not eat the Passover meal again until it was fulfilled. Why is this surprising language for the Passover, and how was the Passover meal fulfilled?
3. Jesus says the cup poured out is the New Covenant of his blood. How does viewing the Lord's Supper as a sign of the covenant affect the way we observe it?
4. After the Lord's Supper, the disciples fell into their old habit of jockeying for position and priority in God's kingdom. How does the Lord's Supper reorient the way we understand honor and glory in God's kingdom?
5. 1 Corinthians 11:26 says that by celebrating the Lord's Supper we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. How does the Lord's Supper teach us to not only look back to Christ's past work, but also to the future when he returns?
