Discussion: Listen to the Sermon Recap Video and continue the discussion from Pastor Chris's prompt.

Discussion: Pastor Chris shared the importance of defining our values in order to build strong relationships in our home. He emphasized that we cannot build a home without intentionality. If we're not careful, our values can be defined by accident because we get caught up in day-to-day activities without taking time to think and act on what is most important to us.

- Are there areas in your life where you have not been as intentional as you would like to be?
- What might distract you from always living according to your most meaningful values?

Have someone read Romans 7:15 & Matthew 6:9

Discussion:

- What do Paul's words in Romans tell us about the common tendency for people to drift naturally away from the things they value?
- What is the significance of Jesus using the words "Our Father" when speaking to God? How does seeing God as a loving father change your perception of how God views you? How might this change the dynamic of identifying and living out your values?

Discussion: Pastor Chris shared that God wants to have a loving relationship with each of us. He explained that in any loving relationship it is essential to consistently spend meaningful time together. He also emphasized the importance of committing to make God a part of every day.

- How could you set aside meaningful time for God each and every day? What does that look like for you? How can we help each other do that this week?
