Scripture Reference: Galatians 6:10

I. Introduction

- Illustration: Leaving the 99 to find the 1 (Luke 15:4–7).

V. Application

- Evaluate your current level of care: Are you going beyond convenience?
- Commit to intentional acts of kindness and outreach.
- Engage in consistent prayer for both the saved and the lost.
