“BIBLE STUDY WITH JESUS PART III”

I. INTRODUCTION – Judas (not Iscariot – we want to make sure that we are talking about the right Judas since Judas was such a common name during this time) asked the last question of the Bible Study. He asked “Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not to the world?” (John 14:22) This will be our Bible Study question for today. Jesus gave us four reasons why He will manifest Himself to us and not the world. **1) Because we have His Father’s love (John 14:23-24). 2) Because we have the Holy Spirit (vss. 25-26). 3) Because we have His peace (vs. 27) 4) Because we have His promises (vss. 28-31).**

II. Because We Have His Father’s Love (John 14:23-24) – If we love Jesus and keep His word, then the Father will love us!

- A) The Son and the Father will come to us and make their home with us! (verse 23, John 14:3)

III. Because We Have the Holy Spirit (John 14:25-26)

- A) It was necessary for Jesus to leave so that the Holy Spirit would come (John 16:7)
- B) We receive the Holy Spirit when we believe and are saved! (Ephesians 1:13-14)
- C) The Holy Spirit is the gift of the Father, He’s another Counselor or Helper, and He will be with us forever (John 14:16).
- D) He reminds us of everything that Christ said (vs. 27). This was crucial in the writing of the Bible and the Church today.

IV. Because We Have His Peace (John 14:27) There are generally three main kinds of peace found in the New Testament.

- A) Peace of God – (Philippians 4:7) This kind of peace eases anxiety
- B) Peace with God – (Romans 5:1) This is a peace that only believers can experience because you must be justified by faith.
- C) Peace on earth – He brings peace on earth on those who is favor rests (Luke 2:14); Jesus is the Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6); and He leaves His peace with us (John 14:27)

V. Because We Have His Promises (John 14:28-31)

- A) Jesus made many promises and has kept and will keep every one of them!
- B) He promised that He was going away (vs. 28). (Hebrews 2:9)
- C) He promised that He was coming back! (vs. 28)



D) The prince of this world was set to come, but Jesus promised that he will be defeated. (John 14:30, John 12:32), (Revelation 20:10)

E) He promised to deliver believers from the power and consequences of sin (Romans 6:14).

F) Jesus promised to return and reign on earth (Revelation 11:15).

VI. Conclusion: Jesus shows himself to those who love him. Those who loves and know Jesus loves the Father and the Father loves him. We receive the gift of the Holy Spirit when we first believe! This is why we have joy!

John 14:31 – “But that the world may know that I love the Father, and as the Father gave Me commandment, so I do. Arise, let us go from here.”
