1. The ______ Schemes of the Enemy

The methods of the enemy of God should not take you by surprise, for God's word has already laid bare the entirety of the devil's schemes. Through deception and temptation, Satan beguiles mankind to turn away from God.

And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. ~ Revelation 12:9

2. The Armor of God
