1. Do Not Be _____

The world is filled with voices ready to deceive. The believer has the obligation to vet all things through the filter of God’s word, and know the difference between vain words and truth.

For such persons do not serve our Lord Christ, but their own appetites, and by smooth talk and flattery they deceive the hearts of the naive. ~ Romans 16:18

2. Do Not Be _____

There can be no fellowship between that which is of the world and that of Christ. To partner with wickedness is to join in. As a small drop of poison taints the whole cup, so a small measure of wickedness stains virtue.

Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? ~ 2 Corinthians 6:14

A man found in Christ is as different from his former nature as light is from darkness. And know this: you were not in darkness, you were darkness. And you are not merely in the light, you are light in the Lord.

For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness. ~ 1 Thessalonians 5:5
