1. The _____ of Christ

Jesus didn't start from earth and then become divine. Jesus has always been the Divine Son of God, the second Person of the Trinity. He descended to the earth in the incarnation and became man so that He could pay the debt of sin for all who believe.

...who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. ~ Philippians 2:6-7

2. The _____ of Christ

At His ascension, the Lord Jesus was enthroned. His inauguration was secured through His death and resurrection, proving Himself to be the Son of God and the Savior of men. He alone is glorified among men and He alone has secured the victory.
