1. An _____ People

Who are “they?” With people from all around the Roman Empire gathered in Jerusalem for Passover and Pentecost, there were some who heard and received the message Peter preached. They, alone, are added into the church.

1 Corinthians 1:30-31 ~ And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, so that, as it is written, “Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord.”

2. An _____ Response

There is no delay in moving from initial belief to determined devotion. It was an immediate and perpetual response of those who came to faith in Christ. Let us, also, set our hearts to the devotion that is necessary for all who believe.

Luke 19:8 ~ And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, “Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor. And if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I restore it fourfold.”

3. An _____ Connection

These four devotions establish the framework for the entirety of the Christian life. God’s word, His people, worship and prayer are foundational to everything we as Christians must pursue.

Ephesians 2:19-20 ~ So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone.

1 Peter 1:22-23

Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart, since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God.
