1. The _____ Truth

A good foundation establishes the stability of a structure. Your Christian foundation must be built from the very beginning of your faith, giving you a constant place to stand when tested.

Hebrews 6:1 ~ Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, and of instruction about washings, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.
