1. _____ Glory

In this moment, the three disciples saw Jesus in His radiance. In Christ there is no darkness at all. And, there will never be any person on this earth who will match the glory of Christ.

Revelation 21:23 ~ And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb.

2. _____ Fear

When the disciples witnessed Jesus in His glory, there was no other response than to bow in fear. A lack of trembling before God Almighty indicates a lack of awareness of who He truly is.

Revelation 1:17-18 ~ When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, "Fear not, I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades."

3. _____ Truth

The Father from heaven proclaims His command that we must listen to the LORD Jesus. Let us not take His word lightly, for Christ has proclaimed the absolute and unwavering truth.

John 18:37 ~ Then Pilate said to him, "So you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

2 Peter 1:16

For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.
