



**THE LORD'S SUPPER:

Matthew 26:26-29

1. The _____ of His Body

No angelic being or sinful human, no matter how great and mighty, could do what Jesus did. For in His willing identification with us, He became the acceptable sacrifice to atone for the sins of all who believe.

Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me." ~ Hebrews 10:5

2. The _____ of His Blood

All the sacrifices of the Old Testament pointed to the One who would lay down His life for the forgiveness of sins. The old covenants find their fulfillment in Christ when He shed His blood to pen the new one.

Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins. ~ Hebrews 9:22

3. The _____ of His Resurrection

In this single, declarative statement, Jesus told His disciples that He would be alive again. His body broken, His blood poured out, but be of good cheer for He will celebrate with His disciples in the Kingdom of God!

For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. ~ 1 Corinthians 15:21

1 CORINTHIANS 11:26-27

FOR AS OFTEN AS YOU EAT THIS BREAD AND DRINK THE CUP, YOU PROCLAIM THE LORD'S DEATH UNTIL HE COMES. WHOEVER, THEREFORE, EATS THE BREAD OR DRINKS THE CUP OF THE LORD IN AN UNWORTHY MANNER WILL BE GUILTY CONCERNING THE BODY AND BLOOD OF THE LORD.
