Book of Esther (selected Scriptures)

1. God's Providential

There is not a single thing out of place in the sovereignty of the LORD. Though we may not understand the reasons why God has us in certain places or under certain conditions, yet the placement of our lives is under His control.

1 Corinthians 7:17 \sim Only let each person lead the life that the Lord has assigned to him, and to which God has called him. This is my rule in all the churches.

2. Haman's Wicked

Built on an ancient hatred, the plot of Haman was to bring to nothing the entire people of Israel. Here we find an illustration of the hatred of the enemy for Christ. He continues to try and destroy all who belong to Jesus.

1 Peter $5:8 \sim Be$ sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

3. Esther's Courageous _____

Esther calls upon the Jewish people to pray, for she would need courage to attempt a rescue of her people. She takes the position that it is worth risking her life that she could be the means by which God would deliver the nation of Israel.

Philippians $1:14 \sim$ And most of the brothers, having become confident in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

4. God's Victory ______

The LORD turned Haman's plans on his own head and he received the judgment that was planned for Mordecai. The greatest enemy is death, but even that enemy will be swallowed up in the greatest victory provided by God: everlasting life.
