1. The Promised _____

What did they have? Faith, that responded in willing submission to the king. Those who have faith in Christ respond in such a way that they invest their lives in obedience to the One who provided the resources.

Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. ~ Colossians 3:23-24

2. The Promised _____

What did they have? Life, vitality, the means and the moments of opportunity, and the common generosity of Divine kindness. It will all be removed, and they will ultimately be removed as well.

But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed. ~ Romans 2:5

3. The Promised _____

Tremble, my friends, at this promise; for we are all counted as enemies of God unless we are found in Christ. God's wrath will be poured out, either on His Son or on those who reject His Son as King.

For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things. ~ Philippians 3:18-19
