Romans 7:1-6

1. _____through Death

As a spouse is liberated from the law of marriage when their partner has passed away, so, through the death of Christ, the believer is no longer bound to the law that condemns. In Christ we have died and are freed from the former regulations.

Let it be known to you therefore, brothers, that through this man forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you, and by him everyone who believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses. ~ Acts 13:38-39

2. _____ unto Christ

A man or woman is not free to marry another so long as the marriage covenant is still in force. But once that bond is dissolved through death, the believer is joyfully united to the One who has died and risen again.

...and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith. ~ Philippians 3:9

3. _____ for God

A marriage is meant to be fruitful and such was our union to sin—being fruitful for death. Now, because we have died in Christ and are bound to Christ we can bear fruit for God through our union with Christ.

I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. \sim John 15:5

JOHN 12:24

Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.
