Walk in the Light Additional Scripture References

1. A _____ Testimony

It is a false testimony when someone claims to walk with God and yet remains in darkness. More than just stumbling in sin, it is an uninterrupted pursuit of sin while professing to walk in the light.

Titus 1:16 ~ They profess to know God, but they deny him by their works. They are detestable, disobedient, unfit for any good work.

2. A _____ Practice

Outside of the truth of God's word, it is impossible to manufacture the continuous expression of real faith. With such false professors will come the failed practice of the Christian life.

2 Timothy 3:5 ~ ...having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people.

3. A _____ Walk

To walk with Christ is to walk in His light and with His people. Even in the midst of the great darkness of our world, the Christian can walk even as Jesus did.

2 Corinthians 4:6 ~ For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

4. A _____ Life

Only in the light will our sins be forgiven. We must walk in the light of the LORD, humble and confident that He will do as promised and wash us clean from all our sins.

Hebrews 9:14 ~ ...how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

John 12:35

So Jesus said to them, "The light is among you for a little while longer. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you. The one who walks in the darkness does not know where he is going."

Matthew 7:21

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven."

Hebrews 10:29
