| Galatians 1:13 \sim "For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it." |
| 2 by Christ |
| Despite the violence and hatred that Saul [Paul] had for the LORD and the church, Jesus comes to rescue the man. |
| Colossians 1:13 \sim He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son. |
| 3 by Christ |
| It is the purpose of Christ to draw men into the body of believers, and through that to encourage and strengthen each other. |
| Hebrews $10:25 \sim$ but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. |
| 4 for Christ |
| God awakens all who believe on Jesus, bringing them out of darkness into light, out of death into life. |
| 1 Corinthians 15:10 \sim But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me was not in vain. |
| 5 in Christ |
| He believed! And his faith established in him a boldness and determination to tell of Jesus to all who would listen. |
