1. A Dreaded _____

Who is able to save themselves? Who is mighty enough to undertake the mission to be the savior of the world? If the scroll remains untouched in the Father's hand, we must weep as well.

1 Corinthians 15:17-19 ~ And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied.

2. A Conquering _____

Oh, Christian, weep no more! There is a Hero—a Savior who has conquered the grave. The mighty Lion of Judah and Root of David has done what no man could: He defeated death and secured eternal hope.

Romans 1:3-4 ~ ...concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord.

3. A Taken _____

Jesus the LORD takes the scroll and in His great authority holds the title deed to all creation. With each seal broken, with each trumpet sounding and each bowl poured out, the final and full redemption is in his hands.

Hebrews 9:12 ~ ...he entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption.

Revelation 5:9-10

And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth."
