Acts 5:27-29

1. In the Midst of _____

The strongest trees often grow in the harshest conditions. God grows his church through conflict, proving His power and grace. In fact, for the church, comfort is far more damaging than conflict.

Acts 14:19 ~ But Jews came from Antioch and Iconium, and having persuaded the crowds, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing that he was dead.

2. By a Spreading _____

When God brings a revolution of the Gospel, it spreads like a wind-driven wildfire. Why? Because it jumps into tinder-ready hearts—from flame to flame—from one soul on fire to another ready to believe.

Acts 16:29-30 ~ And the jailer called for lights and rushed in, and trembling with fear he fell down before Paul and Silas. Then he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"

3. With a Sense of _____

The catastrophic conflict that arises from the Gospel brings a swift condemnation upon those who reject Jesus. The Gospel demands that all men face the fact that guilt resides in every heart for the death of Jesus.

Acts 7:52 ~ "Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who announced beforehand the coming of the Righteous One, whom you have now betrayed and murdered..."

4. Because of Great _____

The revolution of the Gospel in the culture at large springs forth from the courage of those willing to preach it. Do not hold back the truth in this day and age, for a courageous soul can ultimately transform the world.

Acts 23:11 ~ The following night the Lord stood by him and said, "Take courage, for as you have testified to the facts about me in Jerusalem, so you must testify also in Rome."

Matthew 24:14

"And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come."
