### The Good Shepherd

John 10:11-14

# 1. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Shepherd

The proof of a shepherd being good is his willingness to lay his life down for the sheep. And Jesus fulfilled this requirement when, as the Lamb of God, He took our punishment for sin—laying His life down to redeem His flock.

"For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." ~ Mark 10:45

## 2. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Hireling

The hireling has one interest—what can he gain from his association with the shepherd. If a threat arises, and life is jeopardized, the hireling will abandon the flock to spare his own life.

These are hidden reefs at your love feasts, as they feast with you without fear, shepherds feeding themselves; waterless clouds, swept along by winds; fruitless trees in late autumn, twice dead, uprooted. ~ Jude 1:12

### 3. The of the Wolves

Timid and helpless, sheep are defenseless without a shepherd. And the roaming pack of wolves continually stalk their prey, searching out those they can devour while scattering the rest in fear.

Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. ~ 1 Peter 5:8

## 4. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Flock

There is mutual awareness on the part of the Shepherd and the flock. Jesus knows those who are His, and those who are His true sheep know Him.
