Judges 6 – 8

1. God's _____

Too quickly do God's people forget who they are and who God is and what He has done. When God begins to restore His people, it starts with a reminder of what He did and why they are in distress.

1 Peter 2:9 ~ But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

2. God's _____

Restoration is built by God—and God will use His chosen vessel. It will not be the “best and brightest” of the world or the greatest by men's standards whom God will call. But God chooses whom He wills, He chooses those who have faith.

Acts 9:15 ~ But the Lord said to him, “Go, for he is a chosen instrument of mine to carry my name before the Gentiles and kings and the children of Israel.”

3. God's _____

The LORD will have no one boast before Him for God can save—by many or by few. Do not trust in human wisdom or worldly ingenuity. Heed His word and obey what He commands.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 ~ ...and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, so that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.

4. God's _____

Do not elevate or exalt anyone but God alone. And if God should use you, reject the temptation toward putting yourself upon the pedestal of personal glorification.

1 Timothy 6:15b-16 ~ ...he who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see. To him be honor and eternal dominion. Amen.

Revelation 17:14

They will make war on the Lamb, and the Lamb will conquer them, for he is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those with him are called and chosen and faithful.”
