1. Walk in the Right _____

All who are believers in Christ have now a new heart, a new life, a new way, a new value system. To walk worthy of the calling is to walk in the light of the call to salvation.

...so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. ~ Colossians 1:10

2. Walk by the Right _____

A worthy walk is not a theoretical ideal but an actual expression of the new life lived out in real time. It is not just about your internal consideration but your external conduct.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. ~ Galatians 5:22-23
