**1. A \_\_\_\_\_ Day**

The Day of Pentecost is a promised day. Even as Passover presented the LORD Jesus as the faithful and spotless Lamb of God, so Pentecost is the presentation of the church of the LORD Jesus.

*Leviticus 23:15-17 ~ "You shall count seven full weeks from the day after the Sabbath... You shall bring from your dwelling places two loaves of bread to be waved, made of two tenths of an ephah. They shall be of fine flour, and they shall be baked with leaven, as firstfruits to the LORD."*

**2. An \_\_\_\_\_ Church**

God will have you empowered to the work that He has purposed. He does not give you His Spirit and promise His divine strength in order for you to live independent of Him, but that you should walk in faithfulness to Him.

*2 Peter 1:3 ~ His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence.*

**3. A \_\_\_\_\_ Crowd**

The death of the LORD Jesus was a persistent topic of conversation. Now, the same crowd who gathered for Passover and remained through Pentecost, was also a crowd purposed by the LORD to hear the gospel.

*Luke 23:18 ~ Then one of them, named Cleopas, answered him, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?"*

**Matthew 3:11**

**"I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."**

**Exodus 34:22**

*You shall observe the Feast of Weeks, the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the Feast of Ingathering at the year's end.*

**2 Chronicles 8:13**

*...as the duty of each day required, offering according to the commandment of Moses for the Sabbaths, the new moons, and the three annual feasts—the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the Feast of Weeks, and the Feast of Booths.*

**2 Corinthians 10:4**

*For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds.*

**Ephesians 3:7**

*Of this gospel I was made a minister according to the gift of God's grace, which was given me by the working of his power.*

**1 Peter 3:15**

*...but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect.*

**Acts 28:30-31**

*He lived there two whole years at his own expense, and welcomed all who came to him, proclaiming the kingdom of God and teaching about the Lord Jesus Christ with all boldness and without hindrance.*
