1 by Self-Interest
With the warmth of Barnabas' gift still fresh upon the scene, this couple wanted to find the means to step into the limelight and ingratiate themselves to the Apostles.
James 3:16 \sim For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice.
2 to Sin
Premeditated and performed, this couple determined to manipulate the moment through a conspired sin. This was a grave deception as there is no hiding the truth from the Spirit of Christ.
2 Corinthians 6:14 ~ Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness?
3 by the Apostle
What happens when confronted by the truth? Here is the opportunity offered by Christ through the Apostle for Ananias and Sapphira to come clean – to repent and show their hearts.
Matthew 18:15 ~ "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother."
4 by the Holy Spirit
It is a walk upon thin ice to claim to know God and live against Him. The wages of sin is death and with no willingness to repent, this couple found themselves condemned.
