

Digging Deeper Study Guide

Exodus 39-40, Leviticus 1-8

Brief Summary:

In this week's episode, Simon brings us to the close of Exodus and into the book of Leviticus, highlighting the God who chooses to dwell with His people.

He helps us wrestle with the central question Leviticus answers: "How can sinful people live with a holy God in their midst?"

Simon also explores the communal faith God was forming in Israel, showing how the sacrificial system served as a continual reminder—not only of the seriousness of sin—but of God's unwavering goodness, compassion, and mercy.

Finally, he leaves us with a challenging reflection: "Would seeing the tabernacle and sacrificial system change the way I view God—and my sin?"

Study Questions:

1. Where have I begun to downplay sin in my life?
2. Am I treating my faith as something private, when it's meant to be lived in community?
3. Am I truly making space for God to take over every part of who I am?
