

Digging Deeper Study Guide

Deut. 33-34, Joshua 1-8

Brief Summary:

In this week's episode, Mickey highlights how God always has a plan, that His plans are always good, and that when we trust and follow Him, He faithfully directs our steps.

Mickey then explores God's encouragement to Joshua as he steps into leadership, showing how God gives him exactly what he needs and calls him to be strong and courageous. Ultimately, it is God who establishes and exalts Joshua before the people.

Finally, Mickey examines the contrasting stories of Rahab and Achan, demonstrating how faith and obedience can impact generations for good, while sin and disobedience can bring devastating consequences not only to ourselves but also to those around us.

1. Where is God calling you to be strong and courageous, trusting that He is with you and for you?
2. Is there an area of your life where God is asking you to step out in faith, like the priests carrying the ark into the Jordan?
3. Are you seeking God's plans for your life, or are you pursuing your own plans and asking Him to bless them?
