

Digging Deeper Study Guide

Leviticus 9-18

Brief Summary:

In this week's episode, Teddy explores how a holy God teaches His people to live near to Him—and how, when He draws close, every detail matters.

He highlights that God is not casual about His holiness. He will not be treated as ordinary, and neither should His people. God alone defines what is clean and unclean—what is good and right, and what is not.

Finally, Teddy encourages us to intentionally honor God with our lives and our bodies. Holiness is not about perfection, but about being set apart—living differently because we belong to Him.

Study Questions:

1. Where in your life have you made God common, instead of holy?
2. What is one area where God is calling you to draw a clear line—between clean and unclean, between what is right and what is compromise?
3. What would it look like today to live set apart—not perfectly, but intentionally—for Him?
