

# Digging Deeper Study Guide

## John 13-21

### Brief Summary:

In this week's episode, Simon highlights how everything Jesus does flows from being deeply loved by and connected to the Father—and from knowing who He is.

He explains that repentance begins with a renewed vision: changing how we see God, understanding how He sees us, and allowing that truth to reshape how we see ourselves. When those things change, the way we live naturally follows.

Finally, Simon reminds us that the deeper question isn't, "Am I obeying enough?" or "Am I doing this right?" but rather, "Am I living from the truth that I am deeply loved by the King?"

### Study Questions:

1. When I picture Jesus kneeling to wash feet, what does that reveal about how God sees me? And do I truly believe I am loved like that?
2. Where in my life am I still striving, proving, protecting, or promoting myself instead of resting in my identity as a deeply loved son or daughter?
3. If following Jesus cost me comfort, reputation, or security right now, would I trust His love enough to keep walking with Him?
