## WANT TO HELP HOST OUR SIDE BY SIDE HOMEGROUP?

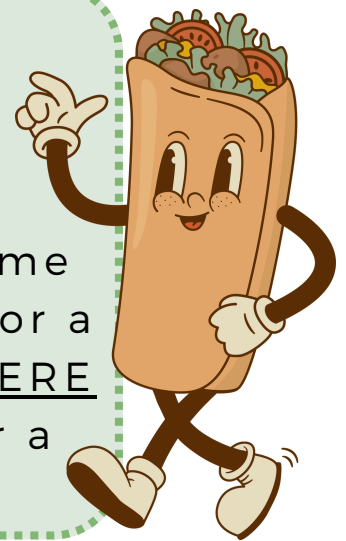
