1 John 1:1-10

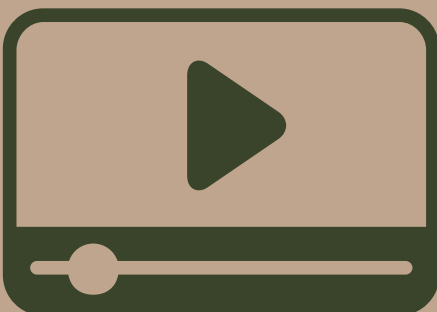
Women of Peace,
