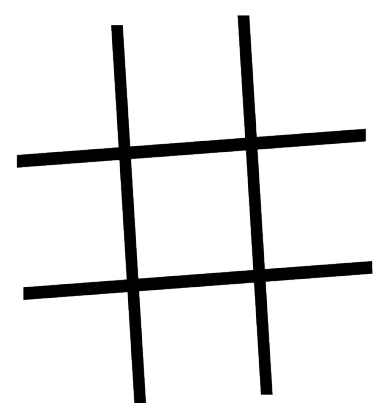
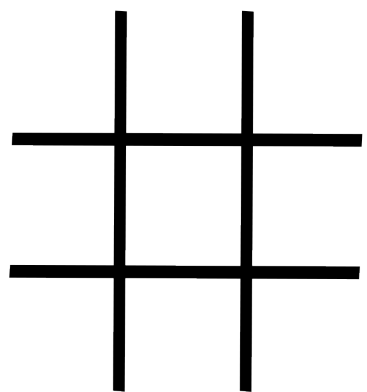
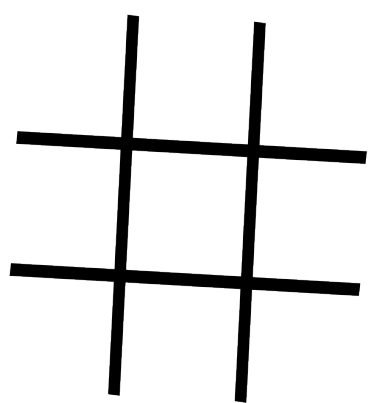

# FAMILY DEVOTION

“I Won't Be Selfish; I'll Share With You!”



“Give generously...for the Lord your God will bless you in everything you do.” - Deuteronomy 15:10

### **SAY:**

God has blessed His children with so much! As sons and daughters of God, we are blessed beyond measure! Sadly, too many kids have a hard time sharing the blessings they have received. Instead, they look at their blessings and shout, “MINE!”

God has not blessed us so that we can keep those blessings to ourselves and be selfish. Instead, God has blessed His children so they can share and bless others!

### **READ:**

2 Kings 7

### **DISCUSS:**

- Who doubted Elisha when he said there would be plenty of food the next day?
- Who was at the gate of the city?
- Where did they decide to go?
- What did the lepers find in the Aramean's Camp?
- What did they decide to do when they stopped eating?

### **SAY:**

Through the story of the lepers who shared, we learn that God can use us to bless others big-time if we are willing to share the blessings He has given us. As we are obedient to God, He will use our blessings to bless others time and time again.

### **PRAY:**

Pray a prayer of thanksgiving with your children. Thank God for His blessings - no matter how big or small we might perceive them to be. Then, pray that each child will choose to share the blessings God has given them in order to be a blessing to others. Pray against selfishness so that others can be blessed as we are blessed!
