SAY:

All around the world, we see the families falling apart. Much of that is because so many of our families—even Christian families—have left behind the idea of being totally committed.

Commitment is something people seem to struggle with in a big way. We walk away from commitments like it doesn't even matter.

READ:

Genesis 32-33

DISCUSS:

- What were the names of the brothers in our Bible Story?
- Who did Jacob trick in order to get Esau's birthright?
- How did Esau react when he found out Jacob had cheated him?
- Was Esau willing to forgive Jacob?
- Should we be willing to forgive our family members no matter what they do?

SAY:

Putting God first in our families, placing our faith in Him, forgiving each other when things go wrong, and staying committed to each other in both good and hard times, are three very important seeds to plant in our families.

PRAY:

Pray for your children to lead a life of faith and commitment in your family. If there is anything they are loving, spending time with, or focusing on MORE than God—lead them in a prayer of forgiveness. Pray that they will be committed to serving God MORE than anything or anyone else. Pray they will forgive their family members when they fail.
