THE ROCK: “Keep Your Eyes On Jesus”



“I Will Keep My Eyes On Jesus!”



“Let us look only to Jesus, the One who began our faith and who makes it perfect...” – Hebrews 12:2 (New Century Version)

SAY:

We all go through storms in life - not just bad weather, but hard times. Jesus told us that in this world we would have trouble. It's just a part of life! We all face difficult times - even children! Children face bullies, sickness, sadness, loneliness, family problems, etc.

READ:

Matthew 14:22-33

DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the disciple who walked on the water?
- What did the disciples think Jesus was when they saw him?
- What happened when Peter took his eyes off of Jesus?
- Did Jesus save Peter from drowning?

SAY:

We learn through the story of Peter walking on water the importance of focusing on Jesus instead of the storm we're in. When we keep our eyes on Jesus, we can make it through the storm!

Focusing on Jesus and His strength and power will help you keep the right perspective and make it through the storms of life. God will bring you safely through the storm!

PRAY:

Pray for your children who might currently be in a storm. Pray that they would keep their eyes on Jesus and focus on His strength and power rather than the storm itself. Pray that God would bring them safely through the storm!
